
Aaron regularly presents at conferences around the world on the work of admissions tests, and has a particular interest in how admissions tests can be used to support widening participation initiatives.

North-Western State Medical University named after I.I. Mechnikov (NWSMU) was formed in 2011 after the merge of two oldest educational medical institutions in Russia. It is now one of the leading centers of the first, second and third cycles of medical training in the north-western part and all over the Russian Federation. Also, Nw SMU provides further training for practicing doctors of all fields in medicine from Russia and other countries.

About 4,750 students are enrolled at NWSMU, among them are 500 students from foreign countries. Besides that, over 1500 clinical residents are studying at University, 460 Ph.D. candidates are doing their postgraduate research.
