AMENDMENTS TO THE ADMISSION REGULATIONS
to the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education
“North-Western State Medical University named after I.I. Mechnikov”
under the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation
to the bachelor's, specialist, master's programs
in 2022 (as amended on 28.01.2022 and on 11.04.2022)

Based on the Decree of the President of the Russian Federation from 09.05.2022 N 268 "About additional measures of support of families of military officers and employees of some federal state bodies", according to the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia from 21.08.2020 N 1076 "About the approval of the procedure of admission to training in educational programs of higher education – bachelor's programs, specialist programs, master's programs", taking into account Methodical recommendations about the organization of admission to training of children of military officers, employees of federal executive bodies and federal state bodies where military service prescribed by federal law and employees of the federal enforcement bodies of the Russian Federation who is (was) involved in military operation in the territory of Ukraine, the Donetsk People's Republic and the Luhansk People's Republic, within the special quota, the following amendments shall be made to the Admission Regulations to the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "North-Western State Medical University named after I.I. Mechnikov" under the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation to the bachelor's, specialist, master's programs in 2022 (as amended on 28.01.2022 and on 11.04.2022) (hereinafter referred to as the Admission Regulations):

1. To supplement paragraph 2 of the Admission Regulations with subparagraph "d" to read as follows:

"d) a special quota for admission to educational programs of higher education (bachelor's and specialist programs), which is set at 10 percent of the total quota for admission from the federal budget allocations for each specialty or training area for children of military officers, employees of federal executive bodies and federal state bodies where military service prescribed by federal law and employees of the federal enforcement bodies of the Russian Federation who is (was) involved in military operation in the territory of Ukraine, the Donetsk People's Republic and the Luhansk People's Republic including those who deceased (died) during military service (hereinafter – the special quota for children of military officers and employees);

2. Para. 3 of subparagraph "3)" of paragraph 8 of the Admission Regulations to read as follows:

"- for the main places within the established amount minus places within the special quota, the targeted quota and the special quota for children of military officers and employees (hereinafter respectively – the main places within the established amount, places within the quotas). If the number of the main places within the established amount is equal to zero, enrollment in these places is carried out when there are no places within the quotas;"

3. To supplement subparagraph "3)" of paragraph 8 of the Admission Regulations with para. 4 as follows:

"to the places within the special quota for children of military officers and employees;"

4. Paragraph 16 of the Admission Regulations shall be supplemented with the following paragraph:

"When carrying out additional admission, the University allocates a special quota for the children of military officers and employees in the amount of 10% of the total established amount for bachelor's and specialist programs in all specialties and areas of training, for which additional admission is carried out."

5. To supplement subparagraph "1)" of sub-paragraph 21.2 of the Admission Regulations with para. "c)" to read as follows: "c) Children of military officers and employees of federal executive bodies and federal state bodies where military service prescribed by federal law and employees of the federal enforcement bodies of the Russian Federation who is (was) involved in military operation in the territory of Ukraine, the Donetsk People's Republic and the Luhansk People's Republic except for those deceased (died), injured (wounded)."

6. To supplement paragraph 21 of the Admission Regulations with sub-paragraph 21.3. of the following content:

"21.3. Results of the entrance tests taken in accordance with para. c) of sub-paragraph 21.2 of these Regulations are not taken into account when applying for places within the admission quota from the budgetary allocations of persons with a special right to admission within the quota, for places within the admission quota for targeted training, for places within the established amount minus places within the special quota, targeted quota and special quota, for training at the expense of individuals and (or) legal entities."

7. To supplement the Admission Regulations with paragraph 35.1 of the following content:
"35.1 Admission to places within the special quota for children of military officers and employees is carried out on the following conditions:

a) children of military officers and employees, except for those deceased (died), injured (wounded) - on the basis of the results of entrance tests conducted by educational institutions of higher education independently;

b) children of military officers and employees deceased (died), injured (wounded) - without entrance examinations.

Children of military officers and employees include citizens of the Russian Federation, one or both of whose parents are (were) military officers and employees.

8. Paragraph 51 of the Admission Regulations shall be supplemented by subparagraph "c)":

"c) when applying for places within the special quota for children of military officers and employees – information that the applicant is a child of military officers or employees.

9. To supplement paragraph 53 of the Admission Regulations with subparagraph 7.1 to read as follows: "7.1) for the purpose of admission within the special quota for children of military officers and employees – documents confirming the corresponding right that are issued by the authorized state bodies (the original or a copy of the document with the presentation of the original). The documents referred to in this subparagraph shall be provided in accordance with the Annex to the Methodical recommendations about the organization of admission to training of children of military officers, employees of federal executive bodies and federal state bodies where military service prescribed by federal law and employees of the federal enforcement bodies of the Russian Federation who is (was) involved in military operation in the territory of Ukraine, the Donetsk People's Republic and the Luhansk People's Republic, within a special quota (Letter of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia from 26.05.2022 N MH-5/1918-ДА)."

10. To supplement the Admission Regulations with paragraph 87.1 of the following content:
"87.1. The results of entrance tests conducted when admitting within the special quota for children of military officers and employees are posted on the official website of the University with the unique code assigned to the applicant.

11. To supplement the Admission Regulations with paragraph 105.1:

"105.1 Based on the results of the admission of documents and entrance tests, the University forms a separate ranked list of applicants for places within the special quota for children of military officers and employees.

The competitive selection list for places within the special quota consists of two parts:

- The first part is the list of children of military officers and employees died, injured (hereinafter - the list N 1).

- The second part is the list of children of military officers and employees, with the exception of those who died, were injured, who have a score for entrance examinations at least the minimum number of points established by the University (hereinafter - list N 2), ranked in accordance with paragraph 108 of these Regulations.

Enrollment of applicants included in the list N 2 is carried out to the places remaining after the enrollment of applicants included in the list N 1.

The unique code assigned to the applicant by the University shall be indicated in the competitive selection list.

12. To supplement the Admission Regulations with paragraph 105.2 to read as follows:

"105.2 When admitting full-time students to the places within the special quota for children of military officers and employees is carried out in two stages in accordance with paragraph 117.1 of the Admission Regulations: at the stage of priority admission and at the main stage of admission.

Admission at all stages within the special quota for children of military officers and employees is carried out if all the conditions established by the Admission Regulations are met and original documents confirming the right to be admitted within the special quota are submitted.

Places within the special quota not filled after the enrollment of applicants to the places within the special quota, are used as main places. The information on enrollment within the special quota shall contain a unique code assigned to the applicant by the University.

These amendments to the Admission Regulations are approved by the decision of the Academic Board dated 27 May 2022, Record № 7.
