ADMISSION REGULATIONS

to the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education
"North-Western State Medical University named after I.I. Mechnikov "
under the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation
for bachelor's programs, specialty programs, master's programs in 2022
(as amended on 28.01.2022)

I. General Provisions

1. These Admission Regulations regulate the order of admission to study in educational programs of higher education - bachelor's programs, specialist programs, master's programs for citizens of the Russian Federation, foreign citizens and stateless persons (hereinafter - applicants) to the federal state budgetary educational institution of higher education "North-Western State Medical University named after I.I. Mechnikov" of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation (hereinafter - the University) in accordance with the license for educational activities.

2. Admission to the main educational programs of higher education for the 2022/2023 academic year at the University is carried out:

- within the limits of the established amount of places for the admission for citizens to study at the expense of budgetary allocations from the federal budget, the budgets of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, local budgets (hereinafter respectively – established amount of places, budgetary allocations);

- under education contracts concluded upon admission to training at the expense of individuals and (or) legal entities (hereinafter - contracts for the provision of paid educational services).

Within the established amount, places are allocated:

a) within the admission quota for targeted training - employer-sponsored education (hereinafter - the targeted quota);

b) within the admission quota for bachelor's degree and specialty programs at the expense of budgetary allocations of persons who have a special right to admission within the quota (hereinafter - the special quota), which is set at least 10% of the volume of control figures for each specialty or training program. If the number of places remaining after the allocation of the targeted quota is not enough to allocate a special quota, the missing places are allocated within the targeted quota with a separate competitive selection for the indicated places for persons who are simultaneously eligible for admission to training within the special quota and targeted quota ;

c) within the established amount of places minus places within the special quota and targeted quota (hereinafter, respectively - the main places within the established amount of places, places within the quotas). If the number of main places within the check digits is equal to zero, admission to the indicated places is carried out if the places within the quotas are not filled.

3. In 2022, the University carries out the planned full-time admission to the following areas of training (specialties):

The University accepts foreign citizens to the program/MD course 31.05.01. General Medicine, implemented partly in English.

4. Persons with an appropriate level of education are admitted to master educational programs, confirmed by:

- a document on secondary general education or a document on secondary vocational education and qualifications, or a document on higher education and qualifications during admission to bachelor and specialist programs

- a document on higher education and qualifications during admission to master's program.

The applicant submits a document certifying the education of the corresponding level (hereinafter - the document of the established form):

- a document on education or on education and on qualifications of the sample established by the federal executive body responsible for the development of state policy and legal regulation in the field of general education, or in the field of higher education, or in the field of health care, or in the field of culture;

- a state-recognized document about the level of education or about the level of education and qualifications obtained before January 1, 2014 (a document on primary vocational education confirming the completion of secondary (complete) general education, and a document on primary vocational education received on the basis of secondary (complete) general education, are equated to a document on secondary vocational education on qualifications);

- document on education and qualification of the sample established by the federal state budgetary educational institution of higher professional education "Lomonosov Moscow State University", federal state budgetary educational institution of higher education "St. Petersburg State University", document on education and qualifications the sample established by the decision of the collegial governing body of the educational organization, if the specified document was issued to a person who successfully passed the state final attestation;

- a document on education or on education and qualifications issued by a private organization carrying out educational activities on the territory of the Skolkovo innovation center or provided for in part 3 of article 21 of the Federal Law of July 29, 2017 N 216-FZ "On innovative scientific and technological centers and on amendments to certain legislative acts of the Russian Federation "by organizations carrying out educational activities on the territory of an innovative scientific and technological center;

- document (documents) of a foreign state on education or on education and on qualifications, if the education indicated in it is recognized in the Russian Federation at the level of the corresponding education (hereinafter - the document of a foreign state on education).

5. Admission for training at the expense of budget allocations is held on a competitive basis, unless otherwise provided by the Federal Law of 29.12.2012 N 273-FZ "On Education in the Russian Federation".

6. Admission to the University is carried out for the first year on the basis of the annual Admission Regulations (hereinafter - the Regulations).

7. Admission for training is held on a competitive basis:

1) for bachelor's and specialist's programs (except for the admission of persons entitled to admission without entrance examinations) - on the basis of the results of the unified state examination (hereinafter - USE), which are recognized as the results of entrance examinations, and (or) on the results of entrance examinations conducted by the University independently;

2) for master's programs - according to the results of entrance examinations established by the University.

8. The University holds a competitive selection for admission on the following admission conditions:

1) separately, in accordance with the direction (profile) of educational programs - a competitive selection within a specialty or a field of study (hereinafter - a single-profile competitive selection);

2) separately within the established amount and under contracts for the provision of paid educational services;

3) separately within the established amount of places:

- to the places within the targeted quota;

- to the places within a special quota;

- to the main places within the established amount of places excluding places within the special quota and the targeted quota (hereinafter referred to as main places within the established amount of places, places within the quotas). In case the amount of main places within the established amount is zero, enrollment to these places is carried out if the places within the quotas are not filled.

4) separately for full-time and part-time studies.

8.1. For each set of conditions specified in paragraph 8 of these Regulations, the University holds a separate competitive selection.

For applicants for bachelor's and specialist programs based on different levels of education, a unified competitive selection is held on the same admission conditions and the same admission basis (if any).

8.2. The persons having the bachelor's degree, specialist diploma, master's degree, can enroll for bachelor's programs and specialist programs only to the places under contracts on the provision of paid educational services.

The persons having a specialist diploma, a master's degree (with the exception of applicants who have a higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification "certified specialist") can enroll for a master's program only to the places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services.

8.3. The single-profile competitive selection specified in subparagraph 1 of paragraph 8 of the Regulations, is carried out on specialty or training program as a whole.

9. For admission to training, applicants submit an application for admission with the attachment of the necessary documents (hereinafter - the documents required for admission; documents submitted for admission; submitted documents).

10. A person who has been granted the appropriate authority (hereinafter - authorized representative) may represent the applicant with a power of attorney issued by the applicant and drawn up in accordance with the established procedure for the relevant actions.

When interacting with authorised employees of the University, the applicant or his/her authorised representative shall present the original identity document.

11. Organizational support of admission for training is provided by the Admissions Board, established by the order of the Rector of the University. The Chairman of the Admissions Board is the Rector of the University. The Chairman of the Admissions Board appoints the responsible secretary of the Admissions Board, who organizes the work of the Admissions Board, as well as in-person appointments for applicants, their parents (legal representatives) and authorised representatives.

To conduct entrance examinations, the University creates Examination and Appeal commissions.

The powers and activities of Admissions Board, Examination and Appeal commissions determined by the regulations, approved by the Rector of the University.

12. When applying for bachelor's and specialist's programs within the established amount of places, the following deadlines are set:

The beginning of the academic year - **September 01, 2022**:

- the starting date for accepting an application for admission and the attached documents (hereinafter - the acceptance of documents) is **June 20, 2022**;

- the deadline for the documents acceptance from applicants based on the results of entrance examinations conducted by the University independently is **July 12, 2022**;

- the deadline for the documents acceptance from applicants without passing entrance examinations conducted by the University independently, including from applicants without entrance examinations (hereinafter - the day of completion of documents acceptance) is **July 25, 2022;**

- the deadline for the University's own entrance tests is **July 25, 2022;**

13. When admitting foreign citizens to the bachelor's and specialist's programs at the expense of federal budget allocations, the deadlines for submitting documents correspond to paragraph 12 of these Regulations.

13.1. Admission to the bachelor's programs and specialist's programs to the places under contracts on provision of paid educational services is as follows:

The beginning of the academic year - **September 01, 2022:**

- the starting date for accepting an application for admission and the attached documents (hereinafter - the acceptance of documents) is **June 20, 2022;**
- the deadline for the documents acceptance from applicants based on the results of entrance examinations conducted by the University independently is **July 12, 2022;**
- the deadline for the documents acceptance from applicants without passing entrance examinations conducted by the University independently is **August 05, 2022;**
- the deadline for the University's own entrance tests is **July 25, 2022;**

13.2. When admitting foreign citizens to the bachelor's and specialist programs implemented in Russian to the places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services, the following deadlines are established:

The beginning of the academic year - **September 01, 2022:**

- the starting date for accepting an application for admission and the attached documents (hereinafter - the acceptance of documents) is **June 20, 2022;**
- the deadline for the documents acceptance from applicants without passing entrance examinations conducted by the University independently is **August 05, 2022;**
- the deadline for the University's own entrance tests is **August 16, 2022.**

13.3. For admission of foreign citizens to the specialist program (MD course) (31.05.01. General Medicine), implemented partially in English, the following deadlines are set for the places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services:

The beginning of the academic year - **September 01, 2022:**

- the starting date for accepting an application for admission and the attached documents (hereinafter - the acceptance of documents) is **September 19, 2022;**
- the deadline for the documents acceptance from applicants is **October 14, 2022;**
- the deadline for the University's own entrance tests is **October 21, 2022.**

14. Admission to the master's program to the established amount of places and to the places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services is carried out from **June 20, 2022 to August 05, 2022.**

Entrance tests for the master's program applicants are held from **06 August to 16 August 2022.**

15. The deadlines of publication of competitive selection lists and enrollment for training (hereinafter - enrollment) are in accordance with section 12 of these Admission Regulations.

16. The University may conduct additional admission to vacant places (hereinafter - additional admission) within the terms established by the University.

II. Establishment of the list and programs of entrance tests, evaluation scales of their results and the minimum number of points confirming successful completion of entrance tests

17. The list of entrance tests for admission to the bachelor's and specialist programs based on secondary general education includes entrance tests in accordance with the order of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation dated August 30, 2019 No. 666 "On approval of the list of entrance tests for admission to training in educational programs of higher education - bachelor's programs and specialty programs."

The results of the Unified State Exam are recognised as the results of general education entrance examinations, or these entrance tests are conducted by the University independently in accordance with these Regulations.

One general educational entrance test is held in one general education subject.

The University does not hold additional entrance tests of professional orientation.

18. For admission to the first year of the bachelor's and specialist's programs in Russian, three entrance tests are established.

Upon admission to the first year of the specialist program/MD course (31.05.01. General Medicine), implemented partially in English, two entrance tests are established.

19. Persons applying on the basis of secondary vocational or higher education may:

- take entrance tests on the basis of professional education, conducted by the University independently, regardless of whether they participated in passing the USE;
- along with passing the entrance tests on the basis of vocational education conducted by the University independently use the results of the Unified State Examination on the corresponding general educational entrance tests.

The University independently determines the form and list of entrance tests for persons entering on the basis of secondary vocational or higher education (hereinafter - applicants on the basis of vocational education), thus for each general entrance test established in accordance with paragraph 17 of these Regulations sets a corresponding entrance test for applicants on the basis of vocational education (hereinafter - entrance test on the basis of vocational education).

For persons enrolling for training on the basis of secondary vocational education:

- Entrance tests on the basis of vocational education shall be conducted in accordance with the training area (profile) of educational programs of secondary vocational education similar to bachelor's programs, specialist's programs, for training for which the admission is carried out (hereinafter - the profile of secondary vocational education), except for the entrance test corresponding to the general entrance test in Russian language, which is held without regard to the profile of secondary vocational education. The similarity of educational programs of secondary vocational education and bachelor's and specialist's programs is established by the University.

The University establishes the following correspondence of general education entrance examinations to entrance examinations on the basis of vocational education for persons with secondary vocational education:

20. Entrance tests are conducted by the University in Russian, except the entrance tests for the specialist program/MD course (31.05.01. General Medicine), which is partially implemented in English. These entrance tests are conducted in English.

21. Admission to the University for the first year of **bachelor's and specialist's programs** is conducted:

21.1. Based on the results of the unified state exam (hereinafter - the USE) in general subjects corresponding to the direction of training (specialty). The results of the Unified State Exam are recognized as the results of these entrance tests. The USE results are valid for 4 years following the year of these results.

21.2. Based on the results of general education entrance tests conducted by the University independently for the following categories of citizens:

1) regardless of whether or not the applicant participated in the USE:

a) disabled people (including disabled children);

б) foreign citizens;

2) for those subjects in which the applicant did not take the USE in the current calendar year: if the applicant received a document on secondary general education in a foreign organization.

Applicants specified in this paragraph may use the USE results (if any) along with the passing of general admission entrance tests conducted by the University independently.

22. When applying for bachelor's and specialist's programs, the citizens of the Republic of Belarus are entitled to provide the results of centralized testing passed in the Republic of Belarus in the current or previous calendar year.

The results of centralized testing are submitted no later than the closing date of admission and are recognized as the results of general education entrance examinations if the applicant did not take the USE in the year in which the centralized testing certificate was obtained.

In order to take into account the results of centralized testing, the following correspondence of the subjects of centralized testing to the general admission tests conducted by the University independently is established:

The results of centralized testing (final result, test score), evaluated on a 100-point scale, are equivalent to the results of general entrance tests conducted by the University independently, including the minimum number of points for each entrance test, and are evaluated with the same number of points

23. As a result of the entrance test, the highest score of the entrance test, which is available to the applicant and is not less than the minimum number of points, is counted in accordance with the established by these Regulations the list and form of entrance tests.

24. General education entrance examinations and entrance examinations on the basis of vocational education conducted by the University independently are held in the form of written form-based testing.

25. Entrance tests for applicants to bachelor's and specialist's programs listed in paragraph 21.2 of the Regulations, with the exception of foreign citizens applying for places under contracts for paid educational services, are held from **July 13 to July 25, 2022**.

25.1. Entrance tests for foreign citizens applying for bachelor's and specialist's programs implemented in the Russian language to the places under contracts for paid educational services are held from **August 06 to August 16, 2022**.

25.2. Entrance tests for foreign citizens applying for the specialty program/MD course (31.05.01. General Medicine) implemented partially in English are held from **October 17 to October 21, 2022**.

25.3 Entrance tests for applicants for the master's program are held from **August 06 to August 16, 2022**.

26. The results of the entrance tests conducted by the University independently for admission to bachelor's, specialist (MD course) and master's programs are assessed on a 100-point scale.

27. For each entrance test, the following minimum number of USE points confirming the successful completion of the entrance test is established:

When admitting for training on the same educational program, the list of entrance tests, the grading scale and the minimum number of points may not differ for admission to various forms of education, as well as for admission to places within a special quota, to places within the targeted quota, to main places within the established amount and to places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services. The maximum number of points for each entrance test is 100 points.

The minimum points cannot be changed during admission.

III. Number of higher education institutions, specialties and (or) training programs for simultaneous admission to the bachelor's and specialist's programs

28. The maximum number of higher education institutions in which the applicant has the right to enter at the same time to bachelor's and specialist's programs is 5.

29. The maximum number of specialties and (or) training programs, in which the applicant has the right to participate simultaneously in the competitive selection for bachelor's and specialist's programs is 5.

30. In each of the organizations specified in paragraph 28 of the Regulations for each of the specialties and training programs specified in paragraph 29 of the Procedure, an applicant can simultaneously apply for training under various conditions of admission.

IV. Special rights for admission to bachelor's and specialist's programs

31. The right to admission without entrance tests in accordance with Part 4 of Article 71 of Federal Law N 273-FZ (within four years following the year of the corresponding Olympiad) is granted to the winners and prize-winners of the final stage of the All-Russian Olympiad for schoolchildren (hereinafter - the All-Russian Olympiad), members of national teams of the Russian Federation that participated in international Olympiads in general education subjects and formed in the manner prescribed by the federal executive body responsible for the development and implementation of state policy and legal regulation in the field of general education (hereinafter - members of the national teams that participated in international Olympiads).

The University has established the following correspondence of the profile of the All-Russian Olympiad for schoolchildren or the international Olympiad to specialties and (or) training programs:

The persons specified in the first sub-paragraph of this paragraph of the Regulations are granted, within 4 years following the year of the corresponding Olympiad, an advantage by equating them with persons who have 100 points in the general educational entrance test (100 points of the Unified State Exam or 100 points for passing the entrance test conducted by the higher education organization independently), if the general educational entrance test corresponds to the profile of the Olympiad.

The University has established the following correspondence of the profile of the All-Russian School Olympiad or the international Olympiad to specialties and (or) training programs for using the advantage by equating to persons with 100 points in the general educational entrance test (100 points of the Unified State Exam or 100 points for passing the entrance test conducted by the higher education organization independently), if the general educational entrance test corresponds to the profile of the Olympiad:

32. Winners and prize-winners of school Olympiads held in the manner prescribed by the federal executive body responsible for the development of state policy and legal regulation in the field of higher education, in agreement with the federal executive body responsible for the development and implementation of state policy and normatively - legal regulation in the field of general education (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiad for schoolchildren), special rights are granted in accordance with Part 12 of Article 71 of Federal Law N 273-FZ (within four years following the year of the corresponding Olympiad):

- 1) the right to admission without entrance tests;
- 2) the right to be equated with persons who have gained the maximum number of USE points in a general subject corresponding to the profile of the school Olympiad.

The special rights specified in sub-paragraphs 1 and 2 of this paragraph may be granted to the same applicant.

Conditions for granting special rights specified in this paragraph (including a list of school Olympiads, based on the results of which special rights are granted, the compliance of educational programs (specialties, areas of training) with the Olympiad profiles, the number of USE scores or a general educational entrance test conducted by the University independently, that confirms the special right) is determined by the Regulations on special rights and benefits provided to the winners and prize-winners of school Olympiads when admitted to the University.

33. When admitting to study within the established amount of places, the applicant uses each of the following special rights to enroll in only one institution of higher education for only one educational program of the applicant's choice (regardless of the number of grounds stipulating the corresponding special right):

The right to be admitted without entrance examinations may be used by an applicant when applying for admission to studies under different admission conditions within the same higher education institution and the same educational program.

34. Within the framework of one competitive selection, on one basis, which gives the right to 100 points (special advantage), the applicant receives 100 points in one general educational entrance test (at the applicant's choice if the University establishes several entrance examinations corresponding to this Olympiad (this profile of the Olympiad).

An applicant can use several grounds at the same time to obtain the right to 100 points (special advantage), including within the framework of one competitive selection.

When participating in several competitive selections, an applicant can use the same basis to obtain the same or different rights to 100 points (special benefits).

35. The right to be admitted to bachelor's and specialist programs from budgetary allocations from the federal budget, budgets of constituent entities of the Russian Federation, and local budgets within the established quota shall be granted to disabled children, disabled persons of groups I and II, persons disabled since childhood, persons disabled due to military trauma or illness received during military service, orphaned children and children left without parental care, as well as to persons from among orphans and children left without parental care, and to veterans of combat operations from among persons listed in sub-paragraph 1 - 4 of paragraph 1 of Article 3 of the Federal Law No. 5-FZ "On Veterans" dated January 12, 1995.

36. The priority right of admission to the University to the bachelor's and specialist's programs, provided that successful completion of entrance examinations and other things being equal, shall be granted to the following persons:

- 1) orphans and children left without parental care, as well as persons from among orphans and children left without parental care;
- 2) disabled children, disabled persons of groups I and II;
- 3) citizens under twenty years of age with only one parent who is a disabled person of Group I, if the average per capita income of the family is below the subsistence minimum, established in the constituent entity of the Russian Federation for the place of residence of these citizens;
- 4) citizens exposed to radiation as a result of the Chernobyl Nuclear Power Plant catastrophe and covered by the Russian Federation Law No. 1244-1 of May 15, 1991 "On Social Protection of Citizens Affected by Radiation as a Result of the Chernobyl Nuclear Power Plant Catastrophe";
- 5) children of military personnel who died in the performance of their military service duties or died as a result of injury (injury, trauma, contusion) or diseases received by them in the performance of military service duties, including when participating in counterterrorism operations and (or) other measures to combat terrorism;
- 6) children of the deceased (perished) Heroes of the Soviet Union, Heroes of the Russian Federation and full holders of the Order of Glory;

7) children of employees of internal affairs bodies, the Federal Service of the National Guard of the Russian Federation, institutions and bodies of the penal system, enforcement bodies of the Russian Federation, the federal fire service of the State Fire Service, bodies for control over the circulation of narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, customs authorities, The Investigative Committee of the Russian Federation, who died as a result of injury or other damage to health received by them in connection with the performance of their official duties, or as a result of an illness they received during the period of service in these institutions and bodies, and children who were dependent on them;

8) children of prosecutors who died as a result of injury or other damage to health received by them during their service in the prosecutor's office or after dismissal due to harm to health in connection with their official activities;

9) military personnel who do military service under contract and whose continuous duration of military service under the contract is at least three years, as well as citizens who have completed military service by conscription and who are entering training on the recommendations of commanders issued to citizens in the manner prescribed by the federal executive body the authorities and the federal state body in which the federal law provides for military service;

10) citizens who have served under contract for at least three years in the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, other troops, military formations and bodies in military positions and dismissed from military service on the grounds provided for in sub-paragraphs "b" - "d" of paragraph 1, sub-paragraph "a" of paragraph 2 and sub-paragraphs "a" - "c" of paragraph 3 of Article 51 of the Federal Law of March 28, 1998 N 53-FZ "On military duty and military service";

11) disabled war veterans, combat veterans as well as veterans of combat operations from among persons referred to in sub-paragraphs 1 - 4 of paragraph 1 of Article 3 of the Federal Law dated January 12, 1995 № 5-FZ "On Veterans";

12) citizens who directly participated in tests of nuclear weapons, combat radioactive substances in the atmosphere, nuclear weapons underground, in exercises involving such weapons and combat radioactive substances up to the date of actual termination of the above tests and exercises, direct participants in liquidation of radiation accidents at nuclear installations of surface and submarine ships and other military facilities, direct participants in conducting and ensuring work to collect and bury radioactive substances, as well as direct participants in liquidation of consequences of these accidents (servicemen and persons from among free-lance personnel of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, servicemen of internal troops of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation or federal state bodies, servicemen and employees of the Federal National Guard Service of the Russian Federation, persons who served in railway troops and other military formations, employees of internal affairs bodies of the Russian Federation and federal fire service).

13) servicemen, employees of the Federal Service of the National Guard of the Russian Federation, the internal affairs bodies of the Russian Federation, the penal system, the federal fire service of the State Fire Service, who performed tasks in the conditions of an armed conflict in the Chechen Republic and adjacent territories classified as an armed conflict zone, and these servicemen performing tasks in the course of counter-terrorism operations in the North Caucasus region.

V. Accounting for individual achievements in bachelor's and specialist's programs

37. Applicants have the right to submit information about their individual achievements, the results of which are taken into account when applying for training.

38. Accounting for the results of individual achievements is carried out through the accrual of points for individual achievements

The points accrued for the individual achievement shall be included in the sum of the competition points.

The applicant submits documents confirming the results of the individual achievements.

39. In admission to bachelor's and specialist's programs the University shall calculate points for the following individual achievements:

39.1. In case of equality of applicants according to the ranking criteria specified in sub-paragraphs 1 - 3 of paragraph 107 and in sub-paragraphs 1 - 3 of paragraph 108 of the Regulations, individual achievements are taken into account determined by the decision of the University Admissions Board during the admission period.

40. The number of points awarded for individual achievements cannot exceed 10 points in total.

VI. Establishing entrance tests and taking into account the individual achievements of applicants for master's programs

41. Admission to master's programs is carried out according to the results of entrance examinations conducted by the University independently.

Entrance tests for this category of applicants are held from **August 06 to August 16, 2022**, in the form of written testing.

The results of entrance tests are evaluated on a 100-point scale. In the training program "Public Health" is one introductory test for which set the minimum number of points confirming the successful completion of the entrance test - 50.

42. Accounting for the results of individual achievements is carried out through the accrual of points for individual achievements.

Points awarded for individual achievement are included in the total competitive selection points.

The applicant submits documents confirming the results of individual achievements.

When applying for a master's program, the following individual achievements are taken into account:

- having a diploma of higher education with honors from an educational institution in the Russian Federation - **10 points**;

- publication activity:

- the presence of published articles in journals included in the international scientific citation bases Scopus, Web of Science - **5 points**;

- the presence of published articles in journals and publications indexed in the Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI) database (with the exception of articles in journals included in the international scientific citation bases Scopus, Web of Science) and in the list of State Commission for Academic Degrees and Titles (SCADT) - **3 points**;

- the presence of a gold medal in the direction of general medicine and dentistry of the Olympiad "I am a professional" - **10 points**;

- the presence of a silver medal in the direction of general medicine and dentistry of the Olympiad "I am a professional" - **9 points**;

- the presence of a bronze medal in the direction of general medicine and dentistry of the Olympiad "I am a professional" - **8 points**.

42.1. In case of equality of applicants according to the ranking criteria specified in sub-paragraphs 1 - 2 of paragraph 109 of these Regulations, individual achievements are taken into account, determined by the decision of the University Admissions Board during the admission period.

43. The applicant submits documents confirming the results of the individual achievement.

The points accrued for the individual achievements are included in the sum of the competition points.

The number of points awarded for individual achievements may not exceed 10 points in total.

VII. Informing about admission to training

44. The University introduces the applicant and (or) his/her parents (legal representatives) with its charter, the license to carry out educational activities, with a certificate of state accreditation, with educational programs and other documents regulating the organization and implementation of educational activities, the rights and obligations of students.

In carrying out admission on a competitive basis, the applicant is also provided with information about the ongoing competitive selection and its results.

In order to inform about admission to training, the University posts information on the official website of the University in the information and telecommunications network Internet (hereinafter - the official website).

The following information is posted on the official website:

1) no later than November 01, 2021:

a) the Admission Regulations approved by the University independently, including; the maximum number of specialties and (or) areas of training for simultaneous participation in the competitive selection (for undergraduate and specialist programs);

deadlines for admission;

information on the granting of special rights and special benefits (for bachelor's and specialist programs);

a list of individual achievements of applicants, taken into account during admission, and the procedure for recording these achievements;

information on conducting entrance examinations in person and (or) using distance technologies;

the peculiarities of the entrance examinations for the disabled and people with disabilities;

the procedure for filing and considering appeals based on the results of entrance tests conducted by the organization independently;

how many times an applicant may submit a consent for enrollment to places within established figures in the full-time bachelor's and specialist programs;

b) the number of places for admission to training under various conditions of admission within the established figures (without specifying a special quota and targeted quota);

c) a list of entrance tests indicating the following information for each admissions test:

name of the entrance test;

maximum number of points;

minimum number of points;

the priority of the entrance test, established in accordance with paragraph 110 of the Admission Regulations;

for the entrance test conducted by the University independently, the form of the conducting, the languages in which the entrance test is passed, the entrance test program;

d) information about the need (no need) for applicants to undergo a mandatory preliminary medical examination;

e) information about the places of documents acceptance, the postal addresses for sending the documents required for admission, the electronic addresses for interaction with the applicants;

f) information about the possibility of submitting the documents required for admission using the super service "Applying to university online" through the federal state information system "Unified portal of state and municipal services (functions)" (UPSS – EPGU in Russian);

g) a sample contract for the provision of paid educational services;

h) information on the availability of the dormitory(s);

2) no later than June 1, 2022:

a) the number of places for admission to training within the established amount of places for various conditions of admission, indicating a special quota and targeted quota;

b) information about the number of places in dormitories for nonresident applicants;

c) the schedule of entrance examinations (with their venues)

3) no later than 5 months before the start of enrollment to the places under contracts for the provision of paid educational services - the number of specified places.

The University ensures the availability of this information for users of the official website from the date of its placement to the day of completion of admission, inclusive.

45. The Admissions Board ensures the operation of special telephone lines and a section of the official website for responding to requests related to admission to training. Multichannel telephone communication is carried out by phone: +7 (812) 3035053. The Internet resource is located at: www.szgmu.ru, Admissions Board section.

46. In the period from the day of the start of admission of documents to the start of enrollment, information on the number of applications for admission to training and lists of persons who have submitted documents required for admission (hereinafter referred to as persons who have submitted documents) for each competitive selection are posted and updated daily on the official website.

VIII. Acceptance of documents

47. For admission to training, the applicant submits an application for admission to training with the necessary documents attached (hereinafter together - the documents required for admission). The University accepts from the applicant the documents necessary for admission, provided that applicant submits a consent to the processing of his/her personal data allowed by the applicant for distribution

(disclosure to an unlimited number of persons) given in accordance with Article 10.1 of the Federal Law of July 27, 2006 N 152-FZ "On Personal Data".

48. An applicant who has submitted an application for admission to study (hereinafter referred to as the application for admission) may amend it through the applicant's personal account or submit a second (next) application for admission under other admission conditions after withdrawal of the previous application for admission to study no later than the closing date of the application.

49. In the case of sending the documents required for admission through public postal operators, these documents are accepted if they were received at the University no later than **18:00 hours on July 25, 2022**.

50. The University shall post on the official website the list of persons who submitted the documents required for admission with the information on the admission or refusal to accept the documents (in case of refusal - with the reasons for refusal). In case of electronic submission of the documents, the notification of refusal shall be sent to the e-mail address indicated by the applicant.

51. **In the application** for admission to study, the applicant indicates the following information:

- a) surname, name, patronymic (if any);
- b) date of birth;
- c) information about citizenship (lack of citizenship);
- d) details of the identity document (including an indication of when and by whom the document was issued);
- e) information about education and a document of the established form that meets the requirements specified in paragraph 4 of the Regulations;
- f) conditions for admission to training and the reason for admission;
- g) upon admission to training in the specialist programs - information about the presence or absence of the applicant's special rights (in the presence of special rights - indicating information about the documents confirming the existence of such rights);
- h) upon admission to bachelor's and specialist programs - information about the USE passing and its results (if there are several USE results, the validity of which has not expired, it is indicated which USE results and in which general education subjects should be used);
- i) upon admission to bachelor's and specialist programs - information about the intention to participate in the competitive selection based on the results of entrance examinations conducted by the University independently (indicating the grounds for participation in the competitive selection based on the results of such entrance examinations and the list of entrance examinations);
- j) information on the need to create special conditions for an applicant when conducting entrance examinations due to his limited health or disability (indicating the list of entrance examinations and special conditions);
- k) information on the presence or absence of the applicant's individual achievements (if any, indicating information about them);
- l) information about the presence or absence of the applicant's need to provide a place to stay in a dormitory during the period of study;
- m) postal address and e-mail address;
- n) citizens of the Republic of Belarus have the right to indicate information on the results of centralized testing passed in the current or previous calendar year, in order to recognize them as the entrance test results.
- o) the insurance number of an individual personal account in the individual (personified) accounting system (number of the insurance certificate of compulsory pension insurance, hereinafter - the insurance number of an individual personal account), if available;
- p) the method of return of the submitted documents (in case of non-admission to training and in other cases established by the Regulations).

52. The following facts shall be recorded in the application certified by the applicant's personal signature:

- 1) familiarization by the applicant with information about the need to indicate in the application for admission the reliable information, and the submission of original documents;

2) familiarization by the applicant with the Admission Regulations approved by the University independently, as well as with the documents and information specified in paragraph 44 of the Admission Regulations;

3) upon admission to study to the places within the established amount:

- upon admission to study in bachelor's programs, specialist programs - the applicant does not have a bachelor's degree, specialist diploma, master's degree;

- upon admission to study in master's programs - the applicant does not have a specialist diploma, a master's degree, with the exception of applicants who have higher professional education, confirmed by the assignment of the qualification "certified specialist";

4) upon admission to study in bachelor's programs and specialist programs:

- confirmation of the simultaneous submission of applications for admission to no more than 5 higher education organizations, including the University;

- when submitting several applications for admission to study at the University - confirmation of the simultaneous submission of applications for admission in no more than 5 specialties and (or) areas of study at the University;

5) upon admission to bachelor's and specialist programs to the places within the established amount on the basis of the right to admission without entrance examinations in accordance with paragraphs 32 and 33 of these Regulations:

- confirmation of the application for admission submission on the basis of the relevant special right only to the University;

- when submitting several applications for admission to study at the University - confirmation of the application for admission submission on the basis of the corresponding special right only to this educational program;

53. When submitting **an application** for admission, the applicant shall also submit:

1) an identity document (documents), document on citizenship (including a passport of a citizen of the Russian Federation that certifies the identity of a citizen of the Russian Federation outside the territory of the Russian Federation);

2) a document of the established form specified in paragraph 4 of these Regulations (the applicant may also submit a document on education of a foreign state with a certificate of recognition of foreign education, except for cases in which, in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation and (or) an international agreement, recognition of foreign education is not required).

The applicant may submit one or more documents of the established form.

3) a document confirming registration in the individual (personalized) accounting system (if available);

4) for applicants specified in sub-paragraph "a" of sub-paragraph 1 of paragraph 21.2 of the Admission Regulations with the intention to take general educational entrance examinations conducted by the University (for bachelor's and specialist programs) - a document confirming disability;

5) if it is necessary to create special conditions specified in paragraph 89 of the Admission Regulations - a document confirming disability or disabilities requiring the provision of these conditions;

6) to use the right to admission without entrance tests in accordance with part 4 of Article 71 of Federal Law N 273-FZ, special rights based on the results of school Olympiads, special benefits (for bachelor's programs and specialist programs) - a document confirming that the applicant belongs to persons who are granted the appropriate special right;

7) to use the special rights specified in paragraphs 35 and 36 of these Regulations (for bachelor's and specialist programs), - a document (documents) confirming that the applicant belongs to persons who are granted the appropriate special right;

8) documents confirming individual achievements of the applicant, the results of which are taken into account during admission (submitted at the discretion of the applicant);

9) other documents (submitted at the discretion of the applicant);

10) citizens of the Republic of Belarus are entitled to submit a certificate indicating the results of centralized testing obtained in the current or previous calendar year;

11) medical certificate form 086/Y (if any);

12) certificate of pre-university training (for applicants to bachelor's and specialist programs) and other documents (submitted at the discretion of the applicant).

Certificate of pre-university training (for applicants to bachelor's and specialist programs) and other documents confirming the applicant's achievements (if provided) may be taken into account by the Admissions Board in the cases specified in paragraphs 39.1 and 42.1 of these Regulations.

13) two photographs of the applicant - for applicants for admission based on the results of entrance examinations conducted by the University.

54. When submitting an application for admission via the UPSS, a document confirming the applicant's citizenship, a document confirming the registration in the individual (personified) accounting system shall be considered submitted if the information on these documents is confirmed by the information available on the UPSS.

A standard document shall be submitted (sent) by the applicant when submitting the documents required for admission, or at a later date, but no later than the closing date set out in the fifth sub-paragraph of paragraph 12 of the Regulations. A certificate on recognition of foreign education (if required) shall be submitted within the same deadline as the standard document.

When submitting an application for admission via the UPSS, a document of established form shall be considered submitted in copy if the information about it is confirmed by the information contained in the federal information system "Federal Register of Information on Documents on Education and (or) Qualifications, Documents on Training". In addition to the above information, an applicant may submit a copy of a standard document for the purpose of accounting for individual achievements and in other cases requiring consideration of a standard document.

55. The documents specified in sub. 4 and 5 of paragraph 53 of these Regulations are accepted by the University if they are valid on the day of submission of the application for admission; the document specified in sub. 7 of paragraph 53 of these Regulations – if it confirms the special right of the applicant on the closing date of documents admission.

56. The applicant may submit the document referred to in subparagraph 7 of paragraph 53 of the Regulations, which does not confirm the applicant's special right as of the closing date, but is valid as of the date of submission of the application for admission. At the same time, a special right shall be granted to the applicant if, no later than the closing date established in the fifth paragraph of subparagraph 1 of paragraph 12 of these Regulations, he/she has submitted a document that confirms this right as of the said date.

57. The documents referred to in subparagraph 6 of paragraph 53 of the Regulations shall be accepted by the University taking into account the deadlines for the granting of special rights set out in parts 4 and 12 of Article 71 of Federal Law N 273-FZ.

58. When submitting the documents required for admission, applicants may submit originals or copies (electronic copies) of the documents, including through the UPSS, without submitting their originals. Certification of these copies (electronic copies) is not required.

When submitting documents via public postal operators, original documents required for admission may be provided at the applicant's discretion.

59. Application for admission to the bachelor's program, specialist programs and master's program shall be submitted in Russian, except for the case specified in sub-paragraph 2 of this paragraph.

An application for admission to the specialist program/MD course "General Medicine", implemented partially in English, shall be submitted in English to the University.

Documents prepared in a foreign language are required to be translated into Russian, unless otherwise provided by the international treaty of the Russian Federation.

Documents received in a foreign state are required to be legalized, unless otherwise provided by the international treaty of the Russian Federation or the legislation of the Russian Federation.

60. Documents required for admission are accepted at the University building at **47 Piskarevsky Pr., building 9, Admissions Office**, St. Petersburg, Russia. Opening hours: Monday to Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

61. The documents required for admission shall be submitted (sent) to the University in one of the following ways:

- a) in-person;

b) via public postal operators at the address: 195067, St. Petersburg, Piskarevskiy prospect, 47, building 35 (for the Admissions Board) FSBEI HE NWSMU named after I.I. Mechnikov, Ministry of Health of Russia.

c) electronically through the University's electronic information system by creating the applicant's personal account on the University portal priem.szgmu.ru and completing an application form with uploading all required documents for admission scanned in Pdf format, with a resolution of at least 200 dpi;

d) sent to the University electronically via the UPSS.

62. If the documents required for admission are submitted to the University by the applicant or the legal representative, the applicant or the legal representative will be issued a receipt for the documents.

63. The University checks the accuracy of the information specified in the application for admission and the authenticity of the submitted documents, including by contacting the relevant state information systems, state (municipal) bodies and organizations.

64. If the applicant has submitted documents in breach of these Regulations (unless the breach applies to all conditions of admission and the grounds for admission as stated in the admission application), the University shall return the documents to the applicant:

- if the documents are submitted to the University by the applicant (legal representative) in person - on the day of submission of the documents;

- in case of sending the documents through public postal operators - within 3 working days after the day of receipt of the documents by the University.

65. When enrolling for training, applicants shall undergo preliminary medical examinations (check-ups).

66. Applicants shall undergo mandatory preliminary medical examinations (check-ups) in accordance with the procedure established at the conclusion of an employment contract or work contract for the relevant position, profession or specialty.

67. Upon receiving by the University of the submitted documents, a personal file of the applicant is formed, which contains an original or copy of the identity document (documents), citizenship, other documents submitted by the applicant, materials for passing entrance examinations, including documents related to the appeal, as well as originals and (or) copies of powers of attorney submitted to the University by legal representatives.

68. The applicant has the right at any stage of admission to training to submit an application on withdrawal of submitted documents (hereinafter – withdrawal of documents). The applicant not included in the enrollment list has the right to apply for withdrawal of the original document of the established form (hereinafter referred to as "withdrawal of the original document").

When documents are withdrawn, the applicant is excluded from the lists of persons who have submitted documents, the lists of applicants, and is not subject to enrollment (excluded from the number of those who are enrolled).

When the original document is withdrawn, the applicant is not excluded from the lists of persons who have submitted documents, the lists of applicants, as well as from the number of those who are enrolled. The previously submitted Consent for enrollment (if any) is valid.

69. Prior to the expiry of the admission period for the places within the established amount for specific admission conditions specified in sub-point 1 of paragraph 8 of the Admission Regulations, the submitted documents or the original document of the established form shall be issued to the applicant upon submission of an application for withdrawal of documents or for withdrawal of the original document, respectively, to the University in person:

- during two hours after submitting the application - if the application is submitted at least 2 hours before the end of the working day;

- within the first two hours of the next working day - if the application is submitted less than 2 hours before the end of the working day.

70. Upon expiry of the deadline specified in paragraph 69 of the Admission Regulations, the submitted documents in part of their originals (if any) or the original document of the established form shall be returned to the applicant no later than 20 working days in accordance with the return method specified in the application for admission. If these originals cannot be returned, they shall be kept at the University.

IX. Entry tests conducted by the University independently

71. The University conducts independently:

entrance tests on the basis of professional education
 general education entrance tests for persons specified in paragraph 21.2 of the Regulations
 entrance test for admission to master's program.

72. Entrance tests are conducted in-class in the form of written testing.

73. Entrance tests are conducted in Russian, with the exception of entrance tests in chemistry and biology for admission to the MD course in General Medicine (31.05.01.), partially implemented in English. These entrance tests are conducted in English.

74. The University does not conduct entrance tests remotely.

75. When the University independently conducts the same entrance tests for different competitive selections, the general entrance test is conducted as one for all selections.

76. Applicant takes each entrance test once.

The results of the entrance tests conducted by the University independently are valid for admission to the **forthcoming academic year**.

77. Applicants who have not passed the entrance test for a valid reason (illness or other circumstances confirmed by appropriate documents: a temporary disability list, a medical certificate, a certificate from another university from which it follows that the day of the entrance test in this university coincides with the day of the entrance test at the University) are allowed to take the entrance test on a back-up day within the established deadlines for entrance tests.

78. The duration of the entrance test in the following subjects: Chemistry, Biology, Russian and Public Health and Healthcare is 2 hours (120 minutes).

79. During the entrance tests, a calm and friendly environment is provided and applicants are given the opportunity to demonstrate their level of knowledge to the best of their abilities.

80. During the entrance tests, applicants and those involved in the tests are prohibited from carrying or using communications equipment.

81. During the entrance test, applicants and those involved may use rulers and calculators that do not contain additional information (formulas, calculations, constants, etc.).

82. It is strictly forbidden to bring textbooks, additional literature into the auditorium, as well as to leave the auditorium during the entrance examination (without being accompanied by authorized University officials).

83. Applicants must bring their passport, a receipt for the documents (if available) and an examination sheet to the entrance test.

83.1. The issuing of the examination sheets starts 2 hours before the entrance test in the entrance test room upon presentation of the passport and receipt for the documents (if available).

84. In case of violation of the entrance test procedure by the applicant, the University's authorized officials have the right to remove him/her from the place of the entrance test with the drawing up of a report on removal. In the case of removal of the applicant from the place of the entrance test, the University returns to the applicant submitted documents.

85. The schedule of entrance examinations (subject, date, time, examination group and place of examination, consultations) is approved by the chairman of the Admission Board or his deputy and announced to the applicants not later than June 1.

The names of the chairmen of the Examination Commissions and the examiners are not indicated in the schedule of entrance tests.

The schedule of entrance tests shall provide for additional back-up time, for persons referred to in paragraph 77 of these Regulations.

86. The results of final examinations at preparatory departments, preparatory faculties, courses (schools) and other tests that are not entrance tests conducted in accordance with the Admission Regulations shall not be accepted as the results of entrance tests.

87. The results of the entrance test shall be announced on the official website of the University no later than the third working day after the entrance test.

After announcing the results of the written entrance test the applicant has the right to see the results of checking and evaluating his work done during the entrance test on the day of the announcement of the results of the entrance test or within the next working day.

According to the results of the entrance test conducted by the University independently, the applicant has the right to appeal to the University about the violation, in the applicant's opinion, of the entrance test procedure and (or) about disagreement with the assessment of the entrance test.

88. Persons who have withdrawn their documents after the application deadline or who received a score lower than the minimum number of points for the entrance examinations will be excluded from the competitive selection.

X. Peculiarities of the entrance test procedure for persons with disabilities and disabled people

89. When conducting entrance tests for applicants with disabilities, the University ensures the creation of conditions that take into account the peculiarities of psychophysical development of applicants, their individual capabilities and health status (hereinafter referred to as "special conditions", "individual characteristics").

90. When conducting entrance examinations in person, the University provides unhindered access for disabled applicants to classrooms, toilets and other facilities (including ramps, lifts, handrails, widened doorways, lifts; in the absence of lifts the classroom should be located on the ground floor of the building).

91. In-person entrance tests for applicants with disabilities are held in a separate room.

The number of applicants with disabilities in one auditorium should not exceed 12 when taking an entrance test in written form.

It is allowed to have more applicants with disabilities in the auditorium during the entrance test, as well as conduct entrance tests for applicants with disabilities in the same auditorium with other applicants, if it does not create difficulties for the applicants when taking the entrance test.

It is allowed to have an assistant from among the University staff or involved persons in the auditorium during the entrance test, who provides applicants with disabilities with the necessary technical assistance taking into account their individual characteristics (to take a seat, move around, read and complete the task, communicate with the persons conducting the entrance test).

92. The duration of the entrance test for applicants with disabilities is extended by a decision of the University, but not more than for 1,5 hours.

93. Applicants with disabilities are provided with instructions on the procedure of entrance tests in a form that is accessible to them.

94. During the entrance test, applicants with disabilities may use technical devices as required by their individual needs.

95. During the entrance examination, the following additional requirements are ensured, depending on the individual characteristics of applicants with disabilities:

a) for the people with blindness:

- the tasks for the entrance examination shall be written in Braille or as an electronic document accessible via a computer with specialized software for the people with blindness, or shall be read out by an assistant;

- written assignments are completed on paper in Braille or on a computer with specialized software for the people with blindness, or dictated to an assistant;

- for the in-person entrance examination, applicants are provided with a set of writing utensils and paper for writing in Braille, a computer with specialized software for the people with blindness, if necessary, to complete the task;

b) for the people with visual impairment:

- individual uniform illumination of at least 300 lux (in the face-to-face entrance examination) is ensured;

- the applicants are provided with a magnifying device for the task if necessary (for the entrance examination in person), it is also possible to use applicant's own magnifying device;

- the tasks to be completed as well as the instructions for the entrance examination are printed in larger font;

c) for the people with hearing loss and hearing-impaired: the applicants shall be provided with shared sound reinforcement equipment and, if necessary, individual sound reinforcement equipment (for in-person entrance examinations), as well as the services of a sign language interpreter;

d) for the people with deafblindness, the services of a special interpreter are provided (in addition to the requirements for the people with blindness and hearing loss respectively);

e) for the persons with severe speech impairment, hearing loss, hearing-impaired entrance tests conducted in oral form shall be conducted in written form (additional entrance tests of artistic and (or) professional orientation, entrance tests in admission to the master's programs - by the decision of the University);

f) for persons with locomotor disabilities, upper limb mobility impairments or absence of upper limbs:

- written assignments are done on a computer with specialized software or dictated to an assistant;

- entrance tests conducted in written form shall be conducted in oral form (additional entrance tests of artistic and (or) professional orientation, entrance tests in admission to the master's programs - by the decision of the University);

96. The conditions referred to in paragraphs 90-95 of the Admission Regulations are granted to applicants on the basis of an application for admission, containing information on the need to create special conditions for the applicant in conducting entrance examinations due to his/her disability, and the document confirming the disability or individual needs requiring the creation of these conditions.

XI. General rules for filing and reviewing appeals

97. Based on the results of the entrance test conducted by the University independently, the applicant (the legal representative) has the right to appeal to the Appeal Commission on the violation, in his/her own opinion, of the established procedure of entrance test and/or on the disagreement with the assessment of the results of the entrance test.

98. A statement of appeal shall be submitted by one of the methods set out in paragraph 61 of the Regulations.

99. The consideration of an appeal is not a retake of the entrance test. During the consideration, only compliance with the established entrance test procedure and/or the correctness of the assessment of the entrance test results shall be checked.

100. A statement of appeal shall be filed on the day the entrance test results are announced or during the next working day. A statement of appeal on the violation of the established entrance test procedure may also be filed on the day of the entrance test.

101. The appeal shall be considered no later than the next working day after the day the appeal was filed.

102. The applicant (the legal representative) has the right to attend the appeal hearing. A minor applicant (up to 18 years of age) has the right to be accompanied by a parent or legal representative, except for minors who are recognized by law to have full legal capacity before reaching the age of majority. The applicant (the legal representative) must have an identity document and the examination paper with him/her.

103. After reviewing an appeal, the Appeal Commission decides whether to change the assessment of the entrance test results or leave it unchanged.

The Appeal Commission's decision, as recorded in the minutes, shall be notified to the applicant (the legal representative). The fact of familiarization of the applicant (the legal representative) with the decision of the Appeal Commission shall be certified by the signature of the applicant (the legal representative).

XII. Formation of ranked lists of applicants and enrollment

104. Based on the results of admission of documents and entrance tests (if any), the University forms a ranked list of applicants for each competitive selection (hereinafter - the ranked list). The ranked lists shall be published on the University's official website and updated daily, including the next day after the Consents for enrollment are accepted, at least 5 times a day from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. local time.

105. The ranked list includes:

the ranked list of applicants without entrance tests (bachelor's programs, specialist's programs);
the ranked list of applicants on the basis of the USE results and (or) the entrance tests conducted by the organization (hereinafter – the entrance tests results), who have scored at least the minimum number of points.

106. Enrollment to the bachelor's programs, specialist's programs based on the entrance tests results shall be made to the places remaining after enrollment without entrance tests, as part of the relevant ranked list.

107. The ranked list of applicants applying for the bachelor's programs, specialist's programs without entrance tests is ranked in the following order:

1) by the status of applicants who have the right for enrollment without entrance tests, in the following order:

- a) members of national teams participating in international Olympiads;
- b) winners of the final stage of The All-Russian Olympiad;
- c) prize winners of the final stage of the All-Russian Olympiad;
- d) winners of schoolchildren Olympiads;
- e) prize winners of schoolchildren Olympiads;

2) for the persons specified in each of sub-paragraphs "a" - "e" of sub-paragraph 1 of this paragraph – by the reduction of the number of points credited for individual achievements

3) in case of equality on the criteria specified in sub-paragraphs 1 and 2 of the paragraph – on the presence of a preferential right specified in paragraph 36 of these Regulations (the higher place in the ranked list shall be filled by applicants with a preferential right);

4) in case of equality on the criteria specified in sub-paragraphs 1-3 of this paragraph – on the individual achievements taken into account in case of equality of applicants in other ranking criteria according to paragraph 39.1 of these Regulations.

108. The ranked list of applicants to bachelor's programs and specialist's programs on the basis of the entrance tests results is ranked in the following order:

1) by the reduction of the number of points calculated as the sum of points for each entrance test and for individual achievements;

2) in case of equality in the number of points – by the reduction of the number of points credited for entrance tests results and (or) by the reduction of the number of points credited for separate entrance test results, in accordance with the priority of entrance tests established by the University;

3) in case of equality on the criteria specified in sub-paragraphs 1 and 2 of this paragraph – on the presence of a preferential right specified in paragraph 36 of these Regulations (the higher place in the ranked list shall be filled by applicants with a preferential right);

4) in case of equality on the criteria specified in 1-3 of this paragraph – on the individual achievements taken into account in case of equality of applicants in other ranking criteria according to paragraph 39.1 of these Regulations.

109. The ranked list for master's programs is ranked in the following order:

1) by the reduction of the number of points calculated as the sum of points for each entrance test and for individual achievements;

2) in case of equality in the number of points – by the reduction of the number of points credited for entrance tests results and (or) by the reduction of the number of points credited for the separate entrance tests results, in accordance with the priority of entrance tests established by the University;

3) in case of equality on the criteria specified in sub-paragraphs 1 and 2 of this paragraph – on the individual achievements taken into account in case of equality of applicants in other ranking criteria according to paragraph 42.1 of these Regulations.

110. For the ranking of ranked lists the University has established the following priority of entrance tests:

1. Chemistry
2. Biology
3. Russian (language)

111. The following information shall be specified in the ranked list:

- 1) individual insurance account number or a special code assigned to the applicant (if there is no individual account indicated);
- 2) for each applicant without entrance tests (bachelor's programs, specialist's programs):
the reason for admission without entrance tests;
the number of points for the individual achievements;
the availability of preferential enrollment rights;
- 3) for each applicant on the basis of the entrance tests results:
the sum of points (for entrance tests and individual achievements);
the number of points for entrance tests;
the number of points for each entrance test;
the number of points for the individual achievements;
the availability of preferential enrollment rights (bachelor's programs, specialist's programs);
- 4) the availability of the Consent for enrollment.
- 5) the presence of an original document of a prescribed type.

The name, surname, patronymic (if any) of the applicants are not indicated in the ranked list.

112. Enrollment shall be carried out in accordance with the ranked list until the established number of places is filled.

Enrollment is made in one or more stages. At each stage of enrollment, the University sets the closing date for submission of Consent for enrollment.

113. Applicants who have submitted the Consent to enrollment between the date of application for admission and the closing date of the Consent for enrollment admission shall be subject to enrollment, provided that they:

in case of admission to training within the established amount of places – the applicant submitted the original document of the established form;

in case of admission to training under contracts for paid educational services – the applicant submitted a standard document (the original document, or a certified copy thereof, or a copy thereof with the presentation of the original), or in case of applying for admission via the UPSS, the information about the standard document is confirmed by data contained in the federal information system "Federal Register of Information on Documents on Education and (or) Qualifications, Documents on Training".

The Consent for enrollment shall indicate the conditions of admission for the specific competitive selection according to the results of which the applicant wishes to be admitted.

The Applicant may submit the Consent for enrollment to the University under various admission conditions.

The University accepts the Consent for enrollment and standard documents every day until 6 p.m. (18:00) local time, up to and including the closing date of the Consent for enrollment admission.

114. In case of admission to the places within the established amount, enrollment is subject to the availability of the original document of established form at the University as of the date of the Order on enrollment.

115. Enrollment within the established amount of places shall be on a competitive basis according to a ranked list from among those applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and provided an original document of established form in accordance with Paragraphs 113 and 114 of the Regulations.

116. The enrollment of applicants to the places under contracts for paid educational services is made on a competitive basis in accordance with the ranked list on the basis of the Consent for enrollment and the signed Contract for the provision of paid educational services. The enrollment shall be carried out until the established number of places is filled.

Applicants who have signed the Contract on the provision of paid educational services and who participate in competitive selection for budget-funded places are enrolled only after all competitive selections for budget-funded places are completed.

When admitting to a full-time course at the University under contracts for paid educational services in bachelor's and specialist programs, the applicant may, at his/her discretion, submit the Consent for enrollment no more than twice.

117. In case of admission to the places within the established amount for bachelor's, specialist and master's programs on a full-time basis:

117.1. Bachelor's and specialist programs:

- 1) on **July 27** the ranked lists are published;
- 2) enrollment is carried out in 2 stages:

The priority enrollment stage:

July 28 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants without entrance tests who have applied to places within quotas is completed;

July 30 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and applied without entrance tests to places within quotas, is issued.

The main stage of enrollment:

August 03 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants who have applied for admission on the basis of the entrance tests results within the established amount of places remaining after enrollment without entrance tests (hereinafter – the main places) is completed;

August 05 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment from among those who have applied for admission on the basis of the entrance tests results to the main places within the established amount remaining after enrollment without entrance tests (hereinafter – the main places) is issued.

- 3) additional enrollment to the main places (if any):

August 08 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants who have applied for admission on the basis of the entrance tests results to the main places within the established amount remaining after enrollment without entrance tests (hereinafter – the main places) is completed.

August 09 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment from among those who have applied for admission on the basis of the entrance tests results to the main places within the established amount remaining after enrollment without entrance tests (hereinafter – the main places) is issued.

4) upon completion of the priority enrollment stage, applicants enrolled to study within the special quota shall be excluded from the ranked lists for the main places, according to the admission conditions specified in sub-paragraph 1 of paragraph 8 of the Regulations under which they are enrolled to study within the special quota;

5) places that have been made available due to the fact that applicants enrolled to study at the priority enrollment stage are excluded from the enrollment list are added to the main places;

- 6) the applicant may submit the Consent for enrollment no more than twice;

7) in case when the Consent for enrollment to the bachelor's programs and specialist programs, full-time form of study, within the established amount of places, is submitted in the availability of the previously submitted Consent for enrollment to the bachelor's programs and specialist programs, full-time form of study, within the established amount of places, the applicant shall submit the Refusal from enrollment in accordance with the previously submitted Consent for enrollment. The Refusal from enrollment is the basis for exclusion of the applicant from the enrollment list.

117.2. Master's program:

- 1) on **August 17** the ranked lists are published;
- 2) enrollment is carried out in 2 stages:

The priority enrollment stage (targeted quota):

August 18 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants who have applied to places within the targeted quotas is completed;

August 19 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and applied to places within the targeted quotas is issued.

The main stage of enrollment:

August 23 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants who have applied for admission on the basis of the entrance tests results within the established amount of places (hereinafter – the main places) is completed;

August 24 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and applied on the basis of the entrance tests results within the established amount of places (hereinafter – the main places) is issued;

118. In admission to bachelor's programs and specialist programs the unfilled special quota places allocated within the targeted quota in accordance with subparagraph "b" of paragraph 2 of these Regulations shall be used as special quota or targeted quota places.

119. Unfilled quota places shall be used to enroll applicants applying to the main places within the established amount based on the entrance tests results and without them.

120. In case of unfilled places after the completion of enrollment, the University may conduct additional enrollment to the specified places in accordance with the ranked lists.

121. Upon enrollment under the Contract on the provision of paid educational services, the established amount of places may be exceeded by the University's decision. By making this decision, the University shall enroll all applicants who have scored at least the minimum number of points, or establish the amount of points required for enrollment (hereinafter – the established amount of points), and enroll all applicants who have scored at least the minimum number of points and have the amount of points (the amount of points for each entrance test and for the individual achievements) not less than the established amount of points.

122. Upon admission to full-time training within the established amount of places in bachelor's, specialist and master's programs, the applicant may, at his/her discretion, submit the Consent for enrollment no more than twice.

123. Enrollment shall be completed before the first day of the academic year.

Information about admission to training without giving the surname, first name, patronymic (if any) of applicants with an insurance number of an individual personal account (if any) or a unique code assigned to the applicant (in the absence of the specified individual personal account), the amount of competitive points, the number of points for entrance exams and for individual achievements are published on the official website on the day of publication of the relevant orders on enrollment and are available to users of the official website for 6 months from the date of their publication.

124. Enrollment to bachelor's and specialist programs implemented in Russian, under the contracts on the provision of paid educational services, shall be held:

August 10 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants is completed;

August 12 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and signed the Contract on the provision of paid educational services is issued.

Additional enrollment to places under the Contract on the provision of paid educational services (if available):

August 18 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants is completed;

August 19 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and signed the Contract on the provision of paid educational services is issued;

August 29 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants is completed;

August 30 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and signed the Contract on the provision of paid educational services is issued

124.1. Enrollment of foreign citizens to bachelor's and specialist's programs implemented in Russian, under the contracts on the provision of paid educational services, shall be held:

August 22 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants is completed;

August 23 – order (orders) on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and signed the Contract on the provision of paid educational services is issued;

Additional enrollment to places under the Contract on the provision of paid educational services (if available):

August 29 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants is completed;

August 30 – order on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and signed the Contract on the provision of paid educational services is issued;

125. Enrollment to master's programs under the contracts on the provision of paid educational services shall be held:

August 29 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants is completed;

August 30 – order on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and signed the Contract on the provision of paid educational services is issued;

126. Enrollment of foreign citizens to MD course (spetsialitet) (31.05.01. General Medicine) implemented partially in English shall be held:

October 26 – admission of the Consent for enrollment from applicants is completed;

October 27 – order on enrollment of applicants who have submitted the Consent for enrollment and signed the Contract on the provision of paid educational services is issued;

XIII. Peculiarities of admission to employer-sponsored training (targeted training)

127. The University establishes a targeted quota in accordance with the admission quota for targeted training established by the Government of the Russian Federation, public authorities of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, local authorities, or with the amount of places for targeted training established by the founder.

128. Admission to targeted training is based on the Contract on targeted training concluded between the applicant and the body or organization specified in Part 1 of Article 71.1 of Federal Law No. 273-FZ (hereinafter – the customer of targeted training), in accordance with the regulations on targeted training and the standard form of the Contract on targeted training established by the Government of the Russian Federation.

129. When submitting an application for admission to targeted training, the applicant shall submit, in addition to the documents specified in paragraph 53 of these Regulations, the concluded Contract on targeted training (the original contract, or a copy of the contract certified by the customer of targeted training, or an uncertified copy of the contract with the original).

130. Admission to targeted training in the interests of state security shall be carried out in the presence of information on the concluded Contract on targeted training received from the relevant federal state body, which is the customer of targeted training and without submission of a copy of the Contract on targeted training by the applicant.

131. In case the federal state body has detailed the targeted quota for the specialty, training area in accordance with paragraph 8 of the Regulations for establishing the quota for admission to targeted training in programs of higher education using budgetary allocations from the federal budget, approved by Resolution of the Government of the Russian Federation of 13 October 2020 N 1681, by setting the number of places indicating the customers of targeted training (hereinafter - the detailed targeted quota):

- The university organizes a separate competitive selection for each detailed targeted quota;
- the applicant participates in the competitive selection for one detailed targeted quota for the given specialty or training area;
- if there are places within the targeted quota for which no customers are indicated, such places are the detailed targeted quota in which applicants who have concluded a targeted training contract with customers not indicated in other detailed target quotas participate in the competitive selection;

- the unfilled places of the detailed targeted quotas shall be used in accordance with paragraph 119 of the Regulations.

132. The list of applicants and the list of applicants for places within the targeted quota shall not include information related to admission for targeted training in the interests of state security.

133. Admission to places within the targeted quota of persons trained in the interests of state security shall be formalized by a separate order(s), which shall not be posted on the official website of the University.

XIV. Peculiarities of admission of foreign citizens and stateless persons

134. Foreign citizens and stateless persons have the right to state-funded higher education in accordance with the international treaties of the Russian Federation, federal laws or the education quota for foreign citizens and stateless persons established by the Government of the Russian Federation (hereinafter – the foreign citizens' education quota), as well as at the expense of individuals and legal entities in accordance with the Contracts on the provision of paid educational services.

135. Admission within the foreign citizens' education quota is carried out in accordance with the guidelines of the federal executive body responsible for the development of state policy and legal regulation in education. Enrollment to study within the foreign citizens' education quota is carried out by separate order(s) of the University.

136. Foreign citizens applying for training on the basis of international agreements, in addition to documents specified in paragraph 53 of the Regulations, submit documents confirming their classification as persons specified in the relevant international agreements.

137. Foreign citizens and stateless persons who are compatriots living abroad (hereinafter – compatriots), in addition to documents specified in paragraph 53 of the Regulations, submit documents provided by Article 17 of the Federal Law dated May 24, 1999 N 99-FZ "On state policy of the Russian Federation in relation to compatriots abroad".

138. Compatriots are not subject to special rights in admission to bachelor's and specialist programs provided in accordance with the Federal Law N 273-FZ, unless otherwise provided by the international treaty of the Russian Federation.

139. Upon admission of foreign citizens and stateless persons to bachelor's and specialist programs implemented in Russian under the contracts on the provision of paid educational services places, the University establishes three general entrance tests in the following subjects: Chemistry, Biology, Russian language.

Upon admission of foreign citizens to MD course (spetsilalitet) (31.05.01. General Medicine) implemented partially in English the University establishes two general entrance tests: Chemistry and Biology, conducted in English in the form of written testing.

140. Foreign citizens and stateless persons may, at their own discretion, apply for training based on results of the entrance tests established for foreign citizens, or on results of the entrance tests specified in section 2 of these Regulations. In the Consent for enrollment the applicant indicates upon which competitive selection results he/she intends to be enrolled

141. Upon submission of documents, a foreign citizen or stateless person shall submit, in accordance with sub-paragraph 1 of paragraph 53 of these Regulations, original identity document, citizenship document or a document proving the foreign citizen's identity in the Russian Federation or the stateless person's identity in the Russian Federation in accordance with Article 10 of the Federal Law No. 115-FZ dated July 25, 2002 "On the legal status of foreign citizens in the Russian Federation", or copies of these documents.

142. A document of the established form shall be provided (sent) by the applicant when submitting the documents required for admission, or at a later date, but no later than the closing date of admission.

The certificate on recognition of foreign education (if applicable) shall be submitted within the same deadline as the document of the established form.

143. Foreign citizens, including compatriots living abroad and not citizens of the Russian Federation, who in accordance with international agreements and (or) federal laws have the right to receive

higher education on an equal basis with citizens of the Russian Federation (on conditions for Russian citizens), shall be admitted to study in accordance with the procedure, conditions and terms established by these Regulations for citizens of the Russian Federation.

If foreign citizens who have the right to higher education on an equal basis with Russian citizens when applying for admission (on conditions for Russian citizens) do not take advantage of this right in the future (after admission), the transfer of these persons to study on conditions for Russian citizens shall not be carried out.

144. Foreign citizens who also have Russian citizenship are considered by the Russian Federation only as citizens of the Russian Federation.

145. Foreign citizens and stateless persons shall be admitted to the educational programs containing information considered to be a state secret within the quota for the education of foreign citizens in compliance with the requirements stipulated by the legislation of the Russian Federation on a state secret.

Current Regulations may be amended by the University Academic Board and approved by the Rector of the University.
