Regulations

**on the language of education in FSBEI HE NWSMU named after I.I. Mechnikov under
the Ministry of Health of Russia**

1. General Provisions

1.1. These Regulations on the language of education in FSBEI HE NWSMU named after I.I. Mechnikov under the Ministry of Health of Russia (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) determine the language of education in FSBEI HE NWSMU named after I.I. Mechnikov under the Ministry of Health of Russia (hereinafter referred to as the “University”).

1.2. These Regulations were developed in accordance with the requirements of:

- Federal Law No. 273-FZ dd. December 29, 2012 “On Education in the Russian Federation”;
- Federal Law No. 53-FZ dd. June 01, 2005 “On the State Language of the Russian Federation”;
- Federal Law of the Russian Federation No. 1807-1 dd. October 25, 1991 “On the Languages of the Peoples of the Russian Federation”;
- Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia No. 245 dd. April 06, 2021 “On the approval of the Procedure for the organization and implementation of educational activities in higher education academic programs – bachelor’s degree, specialist’s degree, master’s degree programs”;
- Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia No. 1258 dd. November 19, 2013 “On the approval of the Procedure for the organization and implementation of educational activities in higher education academic programs – residency programs”;

- Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia No. 1259 dd. November 19, 2013 “On the approval of the Procedure for the organization and implementation of educational activities in higher education academic program – programs for education of academic and teaching staff in the postgraduate studies programs (postgraduate studies in a military college)”;

- Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia No. 499 dd. July 01, 2013 “On the approval of the Procedure for the organization and implementation of educational activities according to additional professional degree programs”;

- Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia No. 1304 dd. October 03, 2014 “On the approval of requirements for learning under additional general education programs that ensure the preparation of foreign citizens and stateless persons for the assimilation of professional degree academic programs in Russian”;

- Other regulatory legal acts regulating educational activities;

- Charter of the University.

1.3. The Regulations are mandatory for use in all structural divisions of the University engaged in educational activities.

2. Language of education

2.1. Educational activities at the University are carried out in the state language of the Russian Federation – Russian.

2.2. Education can be obtained in a foreign language in accordance with the academic program and in the manner established by the law of the Russian Federation on education.

2.3. Teaching and study of the state language of the Russian Federation within the framework of state-accredited academic programs are carried out in accordance with Federal State Educational Standards and Federal State Requirements (hereinafter referred to as the “FSES”, “FSR”).

2.4. Teaching and study of individual academic courses, disciplines (modules), practical training, including those related to the study of foreign languages, as well as the implementation of certain forms of face-to-face learning of students with the teacher, monitoring activities, forms of individual work of the students can be carried out in foreign languages.

2.5. The University determines the methods and means of education, educational technologies and educational and methodological support for the implementation of the academic program (including the use of foreign languages) based on the need for the students to achieve the planned academic program learning outcomes.

2.6. English, French and German are taught at the University as foreign languages. For foreign students, Russian is taught.

2.7. Teaching and study of foreign languages at the University is carried out in accordance with the FSES, FSR.

2.7. Teaching and study of the discipline “Russian language” within the framework of additional general education programs, that ensure the preparation of foreign citizens for learning the academic programs in Russian, is carried out in accordance with the requirements of order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia No. 1304 dd. October 03, 2014 “On the approval of requirements for learning under additional general education programs that ensure the preparation of foreign citizens and stateless persons for the assimilation of professional degree academic programs in Russian” and local regulations of the University.

2.8. Documents on education and (or) qualification shall be executed in the state language of the Russian Federation, unless otherwise established by the applicable law of the Russian Federation.
