**PROCEDURE for
assignment of an increased state academic scholarship
in FSBEI HE NWSMU named after I.I. Mechnikov under the Ministry of Health of Russia**

1. This Procedure for assignment of an increased state academic scholarship (hereinafter referred to as the Procedure) is a local regulatory act of FSBEI HE NWSMU named after I.I. Mechnikov under the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as the University), regulating the procedure for reviewing and selecting candidates from among students of basic professional degree programs – bachelor’s degree programs, specialist's degree programs, master's degree programs (hereinafter referred to as students) in accordance with the established criteria, for the assignment and payment of a state academic scholarship in an increased amount (hereinafter referred to as an increased state academic scholarship).

2. This Procedure was developed in accordance with the Federal Law No. 273-FZ dated 29.12.2012 “On Education in the Russian Federation”, Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 1390 dated 17.12.2016 “On the Formation of a Scholarship Fund”, Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia No. 1663 dated 27.12.2016 “On approval of the

Procedure for establishment of a state academic scholarship and (or) state social scholarships to students with intramural form of study at the expense of federal budget appropriations, state scholarships to postgraduates, residents, assistant trainees with intramural form of study at the expense of federal budget appropriations, payment of scholarships to attendees of preparatory departments of federal state educational organizations of higher education, studying at the expense of federal budget appropriations”, other regulatory legal acts, the Charter of the University.

3. An increased state academic scholarship is awarded on a competitive basis for special achievements in any of the areas of activity (academic, research, public, cultural and creative and sports) of students, no earlier than based on the results of passing two midterm assessments, for University students with intramural form of study at the expense of the federal budget appropriations under the higher education programs (bachelor's degree programs, specialist's degree programs, master's degree programs), including students being foreign citizens and stateless persons, if they study at the expense of the federal budget appropriations, i.a. within the quota established by the Government of the Russian Federation, or as provided for by international treaties of the Russian Federation, in accordance with which such persons were admitted.

A prerequisite for the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship for achievements in the research, public, cultural and creative and sports fields of activity, as well as educational activities (for achievements provided for under sub-clause “b” and “c” of cl. 8 of this Procedure) is the passing by the student of the midterm assessment with “excellent” grades; “good” and “excellent” grades; “good” grades.

4. The increased state academic scholarship is assigned in accordance with the academic schedule for the period from the first day of the month following the month of completion of the midterm assessment, based on the results of which a state academic scholarship is assigned, to the last day of the month of completion of the next midterm assessment.

5. The number of students receiving an increased state academic scholarship cannot be more than 10 percent of the total number of students receiving a state academic scholarship.

6. The size of the increased state academic scholarship and the number of students who are awarded an increased state academic scholarship for achievements in the relevant field of activity are determined by the scholarship commission of the University, taking into account the opinion of the Council of Students of the University and the elected body of the primary trade union organization of students of the University. The opinion of the Council of Students of the University and the elected body of the primary trade union organization of students of the University is communicated by their representatives who are members of the Scholarship Commission of the University at meetings of the Scholarship Commission.

7. The achievements of students for the assigning of an increased state academic scholarship to them shall meet one or more criteria established by this Procedure.

When assigning an increased state academic scholarship, the student's achievements during the period of study at the University are taken into account.

The achievements of students for the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship are taken into account in accordance with the ranking system (Appendix No. 1 to the Procedure).

8. An increased state academic scholarship is awarded **for a student's achievements in academic activities** when these achievements meet one or more of the following criteria:

a) during at least 2 consecutive midterm assessments preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship, a student should get only “excellent” grades (**the evidence is the records of the University (not provided by the student)**);

b) during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship*, a student received an award (prize) for the results of project activities and (or) development work **(the evidence is a copy of the document confirming the receipt of the award (prize) containing an indication of the place and venue of the award ceremony (provided by the student))**;

c) a student is recognized the absolute winner or prize-winner of the international, All-Russian, departmental or regional Olympiad, contest, competition, tournament or other event aimed at identification of the academic achievements of students, held during the year preceding the assignment of the increased state academic scholarship* **(the evidence is a copy of document confirming recognition as an absolute winner or a prize-winner, containing an indication of the place and venue of the award ceremony (provided by the student))**;

If during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship*, an exam (test) is repeatedly passed without valid excuse, an increased state academic scholarship for a student's achievements in academic activities in accordance with the criterion specified in subparagraph "a" of clause 8 of this Procedure shall not be assigned **(the evidence is the records of the University (not provided by the student))**.

9. An increased state academic scholarship is awarded **for a student's achievements in research activities** when these achievements meet one or more of the following criteria:

a) during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship a student should receive one of the following*:

awards (prizes) for the results of research work carried out by the student and not provided for by the educational program being mastered by him/her, the level is an event organized by the University or federal state scientific organizations or federal state educational organizations of higher education **(the evidence is a copy of the document confirming the receipt of the award (prize) containing an indication of the place and venue of the award ceremony (provided by the student))**;

a document certifying the student's exclusive right to the scientific (research and methodological, scientific and technical, scientific and creative) result of intellectual activity (patent, certificate) achieved by him/her **(the evidence is a copy of the patent, certificate (provided by the student))**;

grant for the performance of research work **(the evidence is a copy of the document confirming the receipt of the grant/participation in implementation of the grant (provided by the student))**;

b) a student has a publication in a scientific (academic and scientific, academic and methodological) international, all-Russian, departmental or regional printed edition, in the periodical of the University or another organization during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship*. Publications in peer-reviewed scientific editions indexed in the Web of Science and/or Scopus databases, and (or) included in the list of peer-reviewed scientific publications established by the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia, and (or) editions of the University or other federal organizations registered as a media organization **(the evidence is a copy of the published article containing the article imprint, a printed copy of the article information contained in the citation databases (provided by the student))**;

10. An increased state academic scholarship is awarded **for a student's achievements in public activities** when these achievements

meet one or more of the following criteria:

a) systematic participation of a student during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship* in the conduct of (arrangement of) of socially significant

activities of a social, cultural, human rights advocacy, socially useful nature, organized by the University or with the participation of the University (**the evidence is a copy of the administrative act of the University confirming participation, and a certificate issued by the vice-rector for educational work and youth policy, containing an indication of the dates, place, type and public significance of the specific event(s) (not provided by the student)**);

b) systematic participation of a student within the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship* in activities for information support of socially significant events, public life of the University (**the evidence is a copy of the administrative act of the University confirming participation and the certificate issued by the vice rector for educational work and youth policy, with an indication of a format, regularity, the public importance of the information support which is carried out by the student (not provided by the student)**);

11. An increased state academic scholarship is awarded **for a student's achievements in cultural and creative activities** when these achievements meet one or more of the following criteria:

a) during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship*, a student receives an award (prize) for the results of cultural and creative activities carried out by him/her as part of activities carried out by the University or another organization, including within the framework of a competition, review and other similar international, all-Russian, departmental, regional event (**the evidence is a copy of the document confirming the receipt of the award (prize), containing an indication of the place and date of the award, (provided by the student) and a copy of the University's administrative act confirming participation, and a certificate issued by the Vice-Rector for Educational Work and Youth Policy containing an indication of the dates, place, type and significance of the specific event(s) (not provided by the student)**);

b) during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship*, a student publicly presents a work of literature or art created by him/her (a piece of writing, dramatic, musical-dramatic work, script work, choreographic work, pantomime, musical work with or without text, audiovisual work, works of painting, sculpture, graphics, design, graphic story, comic book, other work of fine art, a decorative or applied art work, stage-set art work, works of architecture, urban planning, garden and park art, including in the form of a project, a drawing, an image, a layout, a photographic work, a work obtained by a method similar to a photograph, geographical, geological, other map, plan, sketch, plastic product related to geography, topography and other sciences, as well as other work), (**the evidence is a copy of the document confirming the public performance indicating the place and date of the public performance (provided by the student), and a certificate issued by the vice-rector for educational work and youth policy containing an indication of the dates, place, type and significance of the specific event(s) (not provided by the student)**);

c) systematic participation of a student during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship* in the conduct of (arrangement of) of public cultural and creative activity of an educational, propaganda nature and other socially significant public cultural and creative activities (**the evidence is a copy of the administrative act of the University confirming participation, and a certificate issued by the vice-rector for educational work and youth policy, containing an indication of the dates, place, type and public significance of the specific event(s) (not provided by the student)**);

12. An increased state academic scholarship is awarded **for a student's achievements in sports activities** when these achievements meet one or more of the following criteria:

a) during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship*, a student receives an award (prize) for the results of sports activities carried out by him/her as part of sports international, all-Russian, departmental, regional events held by the University or other organization (**the evidence is a copy of the document confirming the receipt of the award (prize), containing an indication of the place and date of the award, (provided by the student) and a copy of the University's administrative act confirming participation, and a certificate issued by the Vice-Rector for Educational Work and Youth Policy containing an indication of the dates, place, type of the specific event(s) (not provided by the student);**

b) systematic participation of a student during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship* in sports events of an educational, propaganda nature and other socially significant public sports events (**the evidence is a copy of the administrative act of the University confirming participation, and a certificate issued by the vice-rector for educational work and youth policy, containing an indication of the dates, place, type and public significance of the specific event(s) (not provided by the student)).**

c) compliance with the standards and requirements of the gold insignia of the All-Russian Sports Complex "Ready for Labor and Defense" (GTO) of the relevant age group on the date of assignment of an increased state academic scholarship and completed during the year preceding the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship (priority criterion for assignment) (**the evidence is submission of a copy of certificates for the gold insignia of the All-Russian Sports Complex "Ready for Labor and Defense" (GTO), (provided by a student)).**

13. The increased state academic scholarship is not assigned for achievements in sports activities to students, receiving a scholarship of the President of the Russian Federation, paid in accordance with the Decree of the President of the Russian Federation No. 368 dated 31.03.2011 "On scholarships of the President of the Russian Federation to athletes, coaches and other specialists of sports teams of the Russian Federation by sports, included in the programs of the Olympic Games, Paralympic Games and Deaflympics, champions of the Olympic Games, Paralympic Games and Deaflympics".

14. A student applying for an increased state academic scholarship within the period established by the order of the rector shall submit an application for the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship with the attachment of a set of documents specified in this Procedure. The deadline for submitting documents for the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship is at least 3 working days after the end of the midterm assessment.

The application (see example in Appendix No. 2 to the Procedure) is submitted by a student through a personal account with electronic copies attached (if available) in the application submission service for the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship with the obligatory subsequent submission to the dean's office of the faculty of the original application and appendices thereto.

Based on the submitted applications and attached sets of documents, information contained in the University's records, as well as certificates issued by the **Vice-Rector for Educational Work and Youth Policy**, in accordance with the criteria established by this procedure and the ranking system, lists of candidates are formed for the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship for the following achievements:

14.1. **Achievements in academic activities** – lists are prepared by the dean of the faculty for each area of specialization, the decision is drawn up by the minutes of the meeting of the scholarship commission of the faculty, the extract from the specified minutes is transferred to the scholarship commission of the University.

The number of students applying for an increased state academic scholarship for this achievement cannot be more than **10 %** of the total number of students receiving an increased state academic scholarship.

14.2. **Achievements in research activities** – lists are prepared by the dean of the faculty for each area of specialization, the decision is drawn up by the minutes of the meeting of the scholarship commission of the faculty, the extract from the specified minutes is transferred to the scholarship commission of the University.

The number of students applying for an increased state academic scholarship for this achievement may be **44 % or more (if the number of applicants for an increased state academic scholarship according to other criteria is less than that established in cl. 14.1., 14.3, 14.4, 14.5)** of the total number of students receiving an increased state academic scholarship.

14.3. **Achievements in social activities** – the list is prepared by the department for educational work in general for all applicants, without division into areas of specialization (the set of documents is handed over by the employees of the dean's offices to the department for educational work with the visa of the assistant dean on the student's application about the absence of "satisfactory" grade following the results of midterm assessment, absence of academic arrear), the decision is drawn up by the minutes of the meeting of the scholarship commission of the department for educational work, the extract from the said minutes is transferred to the scholarship commission of the University.

The number of students applying for an increased state academic scholarship for this achievement cannot be more than **30 %** of the total number of students receiving an increased state academic scholarship.

14.4. **Achievements in cultural and creative activities** – the list is prepared by the department for educational work in general for all applicants, without division into areas of specialization (the set of documents is handed over by the employees of the dean's offices to the department for educational work with the visa of the assistant dean on the student's application about the absence of "satisfactory" grade following the results of midterm assessment, absence of academic arrear), the decision is drawn up by the minutes of the meeting of the scholarship commission of the department for educational work, the extract from the said minutes is transferred to the scholarship commission of the University.

The number of students applying for an increased state academic scholarship for this achievement cannot be more than **8 %** of the total number of students receiving an increased state academic scholarship.

14.5. **Achievements in sports activities** – the list is prepared by the department for educational work in general for all applicants, without division into areas of specialization (the set of documents is handed over by the employees of the dean's offices to the department for educational work with the visa of the assistant dean on the student's application about the absence of "satisfactory" grade following the results of midterm assessment, absence of academic arrear), the decision is drawn up by the minutes of the meeting of the scholarship commission of the department for educational work, the extract from the said minutes is transferred to the scholarship commission of the University.

The number of students applying for an increased state academic scholarship for this achievement cannot be more than **8 %** of the total number of students receiving an increased state academic scholarship.

15. The scholarship commission of the University makes a decision on the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship in accordance with the number of students receiving a

state academic scholarship, on the basis of the submitted lists of candidates (extracts from the minutes of the meeting of the scholarship commission of the faculty/department for educational work) and the review of candidate documents.

Other achievements being equal, in the framework of one of the areas of activity, a student with a higher academic performance rating has priority in the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship, and if academic ratings are equal, a more senior student. With the equality of the two indicated features (academic rating and year of study), priority in the assignment of an increased state academic scholarship is determined by assessing other achievements of the student during the study period at the University.

16. An increased state academic scholarship is assigned by order of the rector or an authorized person on the basis of a decision of the scholarship commission of the University for the period specified in clause 4 of this Procedure.

The dean of the faculty is personally responsible for issuing orders on the assignment/termination of payment of an increased state academic scholarship to students.

17. The payment of an increased state academic scholarship ceases from the time the student is expelled from the University.

In this case, the amount of the increased state academic scholarship paid for the month in which the expulsion takes place is determined in proportion to the number of days from the first day of the month to the date of expulsion.

18. Payment of an increased state academic scholarship, shall be stopped from the first day of the month following the month when the student received a “satisfactory” grade during the midterm assessment, or when the academic arrear of the student arose.

19. The student has the right to appeal against the decision of the scholarship commission of the University to satisfy the application or a negative decision no later than the next working day after the notification of the decision made by the scholarship commission of the University.

The appeal no later than 3 working days from the date of its filing shall be considered at a meeting of the appeal commission of the University. The chairman of the appeals commission is the head of the training department. Members of the appeal commission are the head of the department for monitoring educational processes, the head of the department for documentation support of students, the assistant dean, the employee of the department for educational work, the legal adviser of the department for regulation of educational relations in accordance with the order of the rector.

The student who has appealed has the right to be present in person when his/her appeal is considered. Information about the time and place of consideration of the appeal is brought to the attention of the student by the dean of the faculty/department of educational work.

The meeting of the appeal commission may be held in the absence of the student who appealed, in case of his/her failure to appear at the meeting of the appeal commission.

The decision of the appeal commission shall be brought to the attention of the student who filed the appeal within 3 working days from the date of the meeting of the appeal commission. The fact of familiarization of the student who appealed with the decision of the appeal commission is confirmed by the signature of the student.

The decision of the appeal commission is final and is not subject to revision.

*Within a year to the date from which the increased state academic scholarship will be awarded.
