**REGULATIONS**

**on the HUSKY sports student club of Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution  
of Higher Education “North-Western State Medical University named  
after I.I. Mechnikov” under the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation**

**1. General Provisions**

1.1. Regulations on the HUSKY sports student club of Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education “North-Western State Medical University named after I.I. Mechnikov” under the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred

to as the Regulations) regulate activities for the promotion of physical education and sports among students, residents, attendees, postgraduates, doctoral students (hereinafter referred to as Students) and employees of the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education “North-Western State Medical University named after I.I. Mechnikov” under the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation.

1.2. The HUSKY sports student club of the University (hereinafter referred to as the Sports Club) is a voluntary public association of students engaged in the development and popularization of physical education and sports among students and employees of the University.

1.3. In its activities, the Sports Club is guided by the applicable law of the Russian Federation, other regulatory legal acts, the Charter of the University, local acts of the University, as well as these Regulations.

1.4. The Sports Club has its own emblem, sports uniform.

## **2. Goals and objectives of the Sports Club**

2.1. The goals of the Sports Club are:

2.1.1. Advancement of physical education and sports among students and employees of the University. Creating conditions for students and employees of the University to engage in physical education and sports in their time free from study and work.

2.1.2. Propagation among students and employees of the University of values of a healthy lifestyle, encouragement of the creation and implementation of innovative programs and projects at the University aimed at promoting a healthy lifestyle, the development of fitness and sports activities.

2.1.3. Assistance in training of highly qualified medical specialists who meet the modern requirements of employers and achieving the proper level of physical fitness to ensure full-fledged social and professional activities.

2.1.4. Creation of health and fitness groups, specialized sports clubs and teams in various sports, providing methodological and practical assistance in organizing their activities.

2.1.5. Development and implementation of health and fitness and sports programs.

2.1.6. Organization and holding of sports and recreation events at the University. Participation in sports competitions of various levels among higher educational institutions of St. Petersburg, Russia and foreign countries.

2.1.7. Uniting the efforts of students and employees of the University for the development of health and fitness and activities for the general public at the University.

2.2. The objectives of the Sports Club are:

2.2.1. Involvement of University students and employees in systematic physical education and sports activities.

2.2.2. Organization and conduct of work on improvement of sports activity in the University.

2.2.3. Upbringing of physical and moral-volitional qualities, health promotion and reduction of morbidity, increasing professional readiness level, social activity of students and employees of the University.

2.2.4. Carrying out work on physical rehabilitation of students who have a deviation in their health status, involving them in the participation and holding mass fitness and sports events.

2.2.5. Organization of the educational and training process in specialized sports clubs, combined teams of the University.

2.2.6. Preparation of proposals for a long-term development plan and an annual plan of

activities of the University in terms of the development of physical education and sports.

2.2.7. Development of the necessary professional knowledge, capabilities and skills in physical education.

2.2.8. Keeping records of sports achievements of the University.

2.2.9. Providing assistance to general education institutions and educational institutions of primary and secondary vocational education, in which the University conducts career guidance work among applicants, in organizing fitness and sports work.

2.2.10. Volunteer activities of the University.

### **3. Organizational structure of the Sports Club**

3.1. A sports club is created at the facilities of the University from among students.

3.2. The sports club is run by an assistant Vice-Rector for Educational and Social Work. The activities of the Sports Club are coordinated by the Department for Educational Work of the University.

3.3. The activities of the Sports Club are managed by the chairman of the Sports Club and sector leaders by type of activity, elected through a general open vote. The leadership of the Sports Club is approved by order of the Rector of the University.

3.4. The chairman of the Sports Club manages all the activities of the Sports Club and is responsible for its activities before the assistant Vice-Rector for Educational and Social Work, the Academic Board, Vice-Rector for academic work, Rector of the University.

3.5. The competence of the chairman of the Sports Club includes:

3.5.1. General management of the Sports Club activities.

3.5.2. Organization and coordination of the Sports Club activities in accordance with the approved work plan.

3.5.3. Representation of the Sports Club in other institutions and organizations.

3.6. The Chairman of the Sports Club carries out:

3.6.1. Planning and organization of sports work at the University, the work of specialized sports clubs and teams by sports.

3.6.2. Management of the activities of public sports organizers of cohorts, courses and student dormitories.

3.6.3. Preparation of estimates on the financial and material support of the activities of the Sports Club.

3.6.4. Preparation of reports on the work of the Sports Club.

3.6.5. Submission to the administration of the University of proposals for improving sports and health and fitness work.

3.7. The Sports Club creates sectors in the following areas of activity:

- cyclical sports development sector (athletics, swimming);
- game sports development sector (volleyball, basketball, football, table tennis);
- intellectual sports development sector (chess, drafts, e-sports);
- power sports development sector (armresling; martial arts);
- complex coordination sports development sector (aerobics, cheerleading);
- the healthy lifestyle promotion sector;
- student travel club.

This list can be changed depending on the needs of students and the capabilities of the University.

- 3.8. The Sports Club creates a Council, which is an advisory body, the composition of which is approved by the Rector of the University.
- 3.8.1. The Council includes the chairman of the Sports Club, the head of the department of physical education, heads of sectors by type of activity, heads of specialized sports clubs of the department of physical education, coaches by types of sports, representatives of faculties, public sports organizers of cohorts, courses and student dormitories, representatives of student youth organizations. The Council is headed by the chairman of the Sports Club.
- 3.8.2. The Council hears reports on the organization of work in combined teams, specialized sports clubs, groups, amateur associations, etc., considers work plans, calendar plans of sports and mass events, regulatory documents of the Sports Club, submits them for approval by the University administration in the prescribed manner, reviews and approves documents for the assignment of sports categories, makes submissions for the assignment of honorary titles and other forms of incentives.
- 3.9. The public sports organizer of the cohort (course) carries out:
- 3.9.1. Planning, organization and holding of mass health, physical education and sports events for the cohort (course).
- 3.9.2. Creation of sports teams of the cohort (course), preparation and organization of them for participation in the Spartakiad of the University among the combined teams of cohorts, courses and faculties.
- 3.9.3. Carrying out work for the cohort, course and the faculty on visual agitation and promotion of physical education and sports.
- 3.10. The public sports organizer in the student dormitory carries out:
- 3.10.1. Organization of health and fitness and sports work with students living in the dormitory.
- 3.10.2. Carrying out work in the dormitory on visual agitation and promotion of physical education and sports.
- 3.10.3. Organization of work of the sports room.
- 3.10.4. Interaction with local municipal authorities on physical education and sports.

#### **4. Interaction with structural divisions of the University**

- 4.1. In its work, the Sports Club interacts with other structural divisions of the University (department of educational work, department of physical education, faculties, dormitories, etc.).
- 4.2. The interaction of the Sports Club with structural division is organized on the basis of mutually beneficial cooperation in order to effectively use the creative and sports potential of students and employees of the University.

#### **5. Rights of the Sports Club**

- 5.1. The Sports Club has the right to:
- 5.1.1. Award students-athletes and other activists of physical education and mass activities with letters of recognition, promotional gifts.
- 5.1.2. Submit documents for assignment of sports categories, titles of judges by types of sports and honorary sports titles in accordance with the established procedure.
- 5.1.3. Create combined teams by types of sports and send them to participate in sports

competitions of various levels.

## **6. Arranging the activities of the Sports Club**

6.1. The administration of the University bears the costs necessary to ensure the activities of the Sports Club.

6.2. To arrange the activities of the Sports Club, the administration provides premises, mean of communication, office equipment and other necessary materials, tools and equipment for free use.
